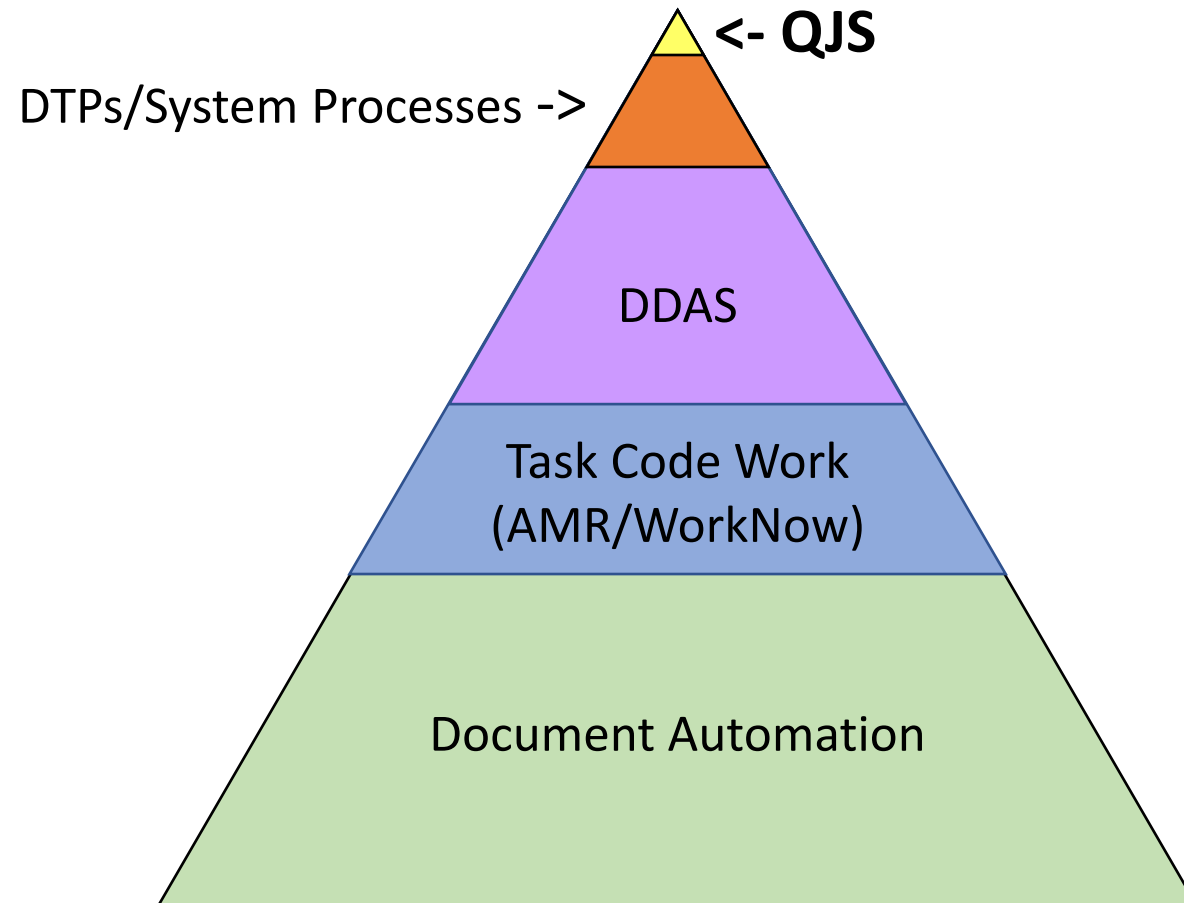

# What is QJS?

- Automated Q-Law to run recurring system processes
- Launched via Windows Task Scheduler
- Kicks off workflow automation

# QJS Setup

- Windows Task Scheduler Configuration
- Hardware Specifications
- Separate QJS Q-Law Icon
  - Uses its own config.fpw file
- Additional documentation in `.\help\Job Scheduler`

# Multithreaded Functionality

- New in QLE
- Allows one PC to launch up to four Job Scheduler processes simultaneously
- MS Word processes are still limited to one at a time
- QLE user account must start with 'JOBSCHED'

# Troubleshooting

- Error Email
- View Job Log (System-wide or job-specific)
- Logs folder
- System Error Log
